THE 2ND NBDSF-SPORTSFESTIVAL IN ÅLAND ON 5.-10.7.2010

DISTINGUISHED SPORTSCLUBS IN THE NBDSF MEMBER COUNTRIES,

Warm greetings from the Finnish Deaf Sports Federation celebrating its 90th anniversary this year! When I am writing this the opening of the Sportsfestival is just 120 days away. After the preliminary registrations it looks like that approximately 430 persons will be participating in the festival, which is almost double the number we had at the first festival, wonderful!

FINAL REGISTRATIONS

We have prolonged the date for the final registrations till **15.4.2010**. (The original registration deadline was by 6.4.2010) Could you please fill out the final registration forms carefully and as realistically as it is possible for you at the moment. The names should be sent by **31.5.2010**.

ORGANISATION FOR THE ACCOMMODATION

Binding accommodation reservations should be made by **15.4.2010**, because a cancellation after that date without cost no longer is possible. Of course it is possible to reserve rooms even after that date, but the organising committee cannot guarantee rooms after **15.4.2010**.

We are happy to inform you that we have been able to book cheaper accommodation from two camping sites. The place of both of these camping sites is excellent. There is accommodation available for approximately 110 persons! Additional information also on other accommodation places besides the camping alternatives can be found in the attached accommodation registration form.

Please note! You should contact the person in charge of the camping sites and make your bookings directly with them. In the hotel alternatives you should contact Fibban Lundqvist and in Hotel Archipelag contact Peggy Björkell.

PARTICIPATION FEES

The organising committee has decided to reduce the participation fee for Latvia, Estonia and Lithuania from 50€/person to 25€/person. The representatives of sports clubs from Sweden and Norway will be charged 50€/person. The Finnish Deaf Sports Federation will cover the participation fees of its own member clubs separately.

THE DIFFERENT KINDS OF SPORTS

The organisation of all different kinds of sports seems to be possible at the moment. As for bowling, a discussion is underway, if it is organised as equalizing competition or in the same way as it was organised before. The question is still open and more information will be sent to you in the next bulletin. There also might be some minor changes in golf. The organisers reserve the rights to make changes in the sports programme, if necessary.
